The validation date, time, and location will be announced soon.

Major Lamb & Goat Validation will take place on <u>Tuesday, October 27, 2020, starting at 5:00 PM (location TBA)</u> ***TLBA or TGBA Tags must already be in the animal's ear before validation – NO EXCEPTIONS***

Please note that all 4-H/FFA orders must be submitted using this form; if a family finds that more tags are needed, please submit an additional form. Additionally, NO refunds will be given on tag orders. <u>All Lambs/Goats must be re-validated to be shown at other shows after State Fair.</u> Please also remember that purchasing a validation tag DOES NOT constitute an entry in a livestock show.

Late Lamb/Goat Validation Tag Orders will be accepted after August 19th up until 12:00 PM on Wednesday, September 23rd, 2020, at the increased cost of \$30.00 per tag. Payment is due at the time of submission.
