INFORMATION, INSTRUCTIONS, & IMPORTANT DATES

Purpose:

The purpose of these Scholarships is to assist students beginning higher education and to recognize outstanding students in Bastrop County 4-H. Applicants should have a sound academic background, exhibit leadership qualities, be an active 4-H member, demonstrate financial need, be of good character and have participated in school and/or community activities. Applicants are considered without regard to socioeconomic level, race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, gender, marital or veteran status or the presence of medical condition or handicap.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be considered for this scholarship, an applicant must:

1. Be actively involved in Bastrop County 4-H, attended high school in Bastrop County, and be a member of a Bastrop Co. 4-H Club.
2. Be enrolled in a recognized vocational school or college.
3. Maintain a grade point average above the level that would result in scholastic probation.

Application Procedure:

An applicant will be given consideration for the scholarship when all the following have been received by the scholarship committee:

1. A completed application (this form)
2. A transcript for all academic work, grade-point average, and college admissions scores.
3. Current year 4-H Recordbook, which may be turned in at the scholarship interview**

For 2020-2021, the Interview will be submitted by applicants as a recorded interview via email or jump drive. Questions will be released to applicants via email on Friday, May 14th.

Award Procedures:

The scholarship money will be awarded to the recipient(s) upon presentation of a current registration receipt from the school of higher education or a check will be made out to the school on behalf of the student.
