We will not approve any Leadership Lab registrations until after check-in of the event. Please keep this in mind as registrations will remain "Pending at District" until we are approved to proceed.*****

4-H CONNECT

REGISTRATION: **May 18, 2021 - May 31, 2021** Any registrations made after closing date of 4-HOnline will incur a **\$50 late fee** in addition to the original event fee. (Pending late entry is approved based on if space is available & no guarantee of shirt after deadline).

WHEN: June 23-25, 2021

WHERE: Texas 4-H Conference Center

COST: **\$250 per Youth & \$220 per Agent.** The cost includes all meals. It **DOES NOT** include transportation to and from or Lunch on Wednesday.

WHO WILL ATTEND:

All District 4-H Council officers plus representatives from each county. All participants must be at least 13 years of age by the date of the Leadership Lab. No graduating seniors who are ineligible to participate in 4-H for the 2021-2022 4-H year may attend. However, current officers who are graduating are allowed to attend.

REGISTRATION: Registration will be conducted on 4-H Connect May 18 - May 31, 2021. Recommend registrants pay for their fees using credit card or debit card. **Any Payments submitted by county/club check through 4-HOnline are due to Texas A&M AgriLife Extension by June 1, 2021.** No personal checks will be accepted. Payments will not be processed until registration is accepted at the District level, this will happen at the close of registration.

**HEALTH & RELEASE
FORMS:**



Every participant, youth, agents and adults, will need to complete a Health and Release form packet. Forms are included in this letter and will be available to download from 4-H Connect. **Please mail TWO (2) copies of the original Health and Release forms to the District Office by June 1, 2021.** Another copy should accompany the participant to camp.

WHAT TO BRING:

Everyone will need to bring their own toiletry items (soap, shampoo, etc), clothing, and other personal items. **BEDDING IS ALSO NEEDED!!!** **For recreation:** swimsuit, sturdy shoes for active games, old tennis shoes, water shoes, some clothes that can get dirty/ruined.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

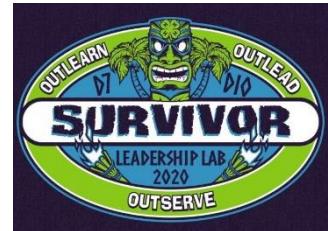
