Horse Project

Our first countywide horse practice will be Sunday, March 5th at 3pm at the rodeo arena in Floydada. We will have one county practice per month that will be open to anyone currently enrolled in 4-H. Please note, in order to bring your horse to practice you MUST have a current negative coggins test and health papers from a vet. You will not be allowed to practice if you are not enrolled in 4-H (for insurance and safety reasons) or if your horse is not current on health requirements. Please bring all necessary documents to the first practice. The Big 5 Horse Show Association is open for enrollment on their web site: www.big5horseshow.com. If you plan on competing please make sure you get registered as a member ASAP. The fee increases from \$20 to \$40 after March 10th. The first Big 5 Horse Show will be in Amarillo this month. Shooting Sports Extravaganza

If you're new to shooting sports, this is the place to start! The Shooting Sports Extravaganza is a beginner's match and learning event. Beginner shooters will learn the process of shooting competitively, basic knowledge of firearm and range safety, and about the shooting sports events. Extravaganza will be held April 22 and the 4-H Center in Brownwood. Registration is February 15 through March 19 for \$25. Late registration is March 20 through March 26 for \$40. If you are interested and would like more information, contact a shooting sports coach or the CEO.

Livestock Judging

Our first livestock judging competition will be in Clarendon on Saturday April 1st. The South Plains College competition will be the following Friday, April 7th in Levelland. Fashion Storyboard

The 4-H Fashion Storyboard is an industry-inspired method of displaying original designs. The storyboard "tells the story" of the designer's idea. The storyboard includes original illustrations and flats, as well as additional materials (such as photos from the Internet or magazines, paper, fabric swatches, patterns, etc.) that have influenced the unique design. Storyboards can be created and entered in one category.

- a. Wearable: Clothing that can be worn. Includes items such as pants, shorts, skirts, blouses, sweaters, coats, dresses, etc.
- b. Accessory: Includes items such as belts, purses, bags, hats, etc.
- c. Jewelry: Includes necklaces, bracelets, rings, and earrings.
- d. Non-Wearable: Includes items such as pillows, organizers, holiday items, stuffed animals, items for the home, etc.
- e. Pet Clothing: Includes items that can be worn by a pet or any other animal.

The following design brief serves as the direction for the 2017 Fashion Storyboards. 4-H members should create their Fashion Storyboard around their interpretation of the design brief.

"Inspired By Music"

Whether you're heading to a concert, going dancing with friends or just hanging out at home listening to your favorite tunes, let your style choices reflect your musical taste with designs inspired by melody, tune, harmony, composition and song. From the rapid lively tempo of country music banjos, the slow sad moan of the blues, or the edgy upbeat rhythm of hip hop, there is a melodic palette for everyone.

State Indoor Archery Contest

Date for the 2017 State Indoor Archery Match have been released. Madisonville will be March 10 and 11. Bay City is March 24 and 25. Ft. Stockton is March 25 and Graham is March 31 and April 1. Registration will be through 4-H Connect. The fee is \$30 (\$25 entry fee & \$5 target fee) per bow class. Late fee is \$50 (\$45 entry fee & \$5 target fee) per bow class. Registration is now open and will be available until March 9th. If you are interested in competing or would like more information, contact a shooting sports coach or the CEO.

In the Texas 4-H Youth Development Program, 4-H members participate in the 4-H Clothing & Textile project to become knowledgeable in a multitude of concentrated skills including, but not limited to, design, construction and consumer buying. The Texas 4-H Duds to Dazzle qualifying competition has taken another step in expanding the learning experience by "going green" through the introduction of eco-fashion. The objectives of the contest are: Allow participants to exhibit knowledge and skills gained through their 4-H Clothing & Textiles project by designing, constructing, and presenting a finished product; Allow participants learning opportunities; Promote teamwork; Help 4-H'ers gain experience in public speaking; Provide leadership opportunities for young people; Assist youth in gaining an appreciation for recycling textiles so that they do not end up in the waste stream


