

FUTURE FARMERS
FARM SHOP EXHIBITS

The purpose of this division is to encourage greater use of the farm shop in making implements for home-farm use and to display to the general public through exhibits, some of the values of vocational agricultural training.

1. All projects must be constructed under the supervision of a Vocational Agricultural teacher.
2. All exhibitors of shop projects must be a member of an FFA chapter within Live Oak County.
3. No student can enter more than two (2) individual projects.
4. All projects will be on merit, quality and workmanship.
5. Each exhibitor is responsible for care of their project during the fair.
6. Each project will be graded as follows:

A.	90-100 Blue ribbon	\$20.00
B.	80-89 Red Ribbon	\$15.00
C.	70-79 White Ribbon	\$10.00
D.	60 or less – No Score	
7. All projects must be checked in on Wednesday, March 1 between 3:00 - 6:00 p.m. No late entries will be accepted. An Ag Science Instructor from each chapter must be present at check in.
8. Entry fee of \$3.00 per exhibit will be deducted from the grade money.
9. Must be the work of the individual exhibitor or designated group only. Each group will consist of no more than five students. No chapter projects to be allowed.
10. Exhibits must be removed from the fairgrounds no earlier than 3 p.m. and no later than 4 p.m. on Saturday.
11. Shop projects will be divided into two classes - Wood and Metal. Classifying of projects will be determined at check in by the exhibitor.
12. Grand Champion Shop projects must sell in the silent auction. All other participants may choose to participate in the silent auction.
13. All farm shop exhibits will be judged Thursday, March 2.
14. Each exhibitor must be present during the judging of their shop project, unless excused by the ag science teacher.
15. All shop exhibits must be constructed within one calendar year of the exhibition date.
16. Silent Auction Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.
17. All Silent Auction shop projects must go through the Live Oak County Fair with 3% commission deducted from the project.
18. Projects must be sold as shown during the judging. No changing or altering of parts.
