2020 Navarro County 4-H Chili Cook-Off

1. Teams/Individuals must pay the specified entry fee for Age Division and Category
 - a. Adult - \$25 / Youth - \$15
 - i. Traditional (Based on Tolbert Rules) / Non – Traditional
2. Teams may wish to decorate their booth and/or team members according to a theme. Teams are encouraged to do so but must supply all necessary materials and equipment (there is a showmanship trophy).
3. Teams must supply their own chili ingredients, cooking equipment and fuel. You are encouraged to bring canopy's tables, and chairs. Remember you must have a portable stove or fryer because electricity is NOT available.
4. Chili must be prepared out in the open in as sanitary manner as possible, we encourage to make enough to accommodate for the judging and tasting
5. You may use beef, turkey, chicken, rabbit, deer.
6. Judging will begin at 2:00 and will start tallying at 3:15.
 - a. Awards will be presented after tabulation.

TRADITIONAL CHILI

1. Teams must arrive at chili grounds(8:00am – 9:30 am) and complete chili prior to judging time.
2. Teams must supply their own chili ingredients, cooking equipment and fuel. You are encouraged to bring canopy's tables, and chairs. Remember you must have a portable stove or fryer because electricity is NOT available.
3. No Traditional team will start preparation or cooking prior to official start time.(10:00 am)
4. Chili must be cooked on site the day of the cookoff from scratch. "Scratch" means starting with raw meat of choice and using regular spices. Commercial chili powder is permissible, but complete commercial chili mixes are NOT permitted.
5. Chili must be prepared out in the open in as sanitary a manner as possible.
6. No beans, pasta, rice or other similar items are allowed.

NON-TRADITIONAL CHILI

1. Can cook at on site or brought from home
 - a. Non-Traditional cooked at home must arrive and be set up before judging begins (1:00 – 1:30)
2. Chili must be prepared in as sanitary a manner as possible.
3. Can use any Meat/ingredients/ recipe you wish.
4. Beans, pasta, rice or other similar items are allowed.
