

## Val Verde Junior Livestock Show COVID-19 Prevention and Preparedness Plan

We are excited to host the 80<sup>th</sup> Annual Val Verde Junior Livestock Show, however the Val Verde Junior Livestock Show in partnership with Val Verde County understand the need to comply with all local, state, and Texas 4-H guidelines and procedures to keep our exhibitors and their family safe. As this is a fluid situation some or all the following COVID-19 prevention methods may be in place during the Val Verde Junior Livestock Show:

- 6-foot social distancing practices
- Face covering requirements
- COVID-19 Health and Safety Screening procedures
- COVID – 19 Precautions and preventative measures signage
- Limited capacity of facility –
  - Wristbands will be required to attend the Val Verde Junior Livestock Show. Each family will receive 4 wristbands in addition to 1 wristband per exhibitor.
  - Exhibitor and their family are to only be at the show grounds when the species they are exhibiting is scheduled to be on the grounds.
- Modified schedule
- Alternative show location
- Increased sanitation of high touch surfaces
- Sanitation stations located throughout the facility
- Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service employees will be trained using TAMU COVID Employee training on health and safety protocols.
