

Val Verde Junior Livestock Show Rule Adjustments due to COVID-19

- 1) General Rule 1.
If the show is held on the alternative show date of February 26th and 27th. Exhibitors may receive a waiver from the County Extension Agent to show only 1 animal at the Val Verde Junior Livestock Show if 1) Exhibitor has shown at major show that is terminal prior to the county stock show (San Angelo or San Antonio) 2) Exhibitor validated a minimum of 2 head at the time of validation. (If validated as a family unit – must have validated 2 per an exhibitor)
- 2) General Rule 3.
Due to COVID-19 a modified schedule will be in place – please reference the modified schedule.
- 3) General Rule 5.
If youth are unable to participate in the Val Verde County Junior Livestock Show due to being unable to pass the COVID-19 health and screening protocols set forth by the board they will be granted a waiver to allow a substitute exhibitor to exhibit their animal. Exhibitors will be responsible with communicating and working with the livestock show board and county agent to get livestock to the grounds.
- 4) Junior Market Lamb Show Rule 5.
All lambs for the Val Verde County 4-H Livestock Show will be shorn prior to November 21st. If the show is held on the alternative show date of February 26th and 27th lambs will be shorn prior to January 23rd. (Lambs showing at Kerrville will comply with the new shear date). The county extension office will publicize dates that shears will be available at the show barn for shearing.
- 5) Junior Market Lamb Show Rule 10.
Weight limits for all market lambs if the show is held December 19th and 20th will be as follows:
75 pounds (FW, FWX, MW) and 65 pounds for Hair Sheep.
- 6) Junior Market Lamb Show Rule 13.
Due to COVID-19 a modified schedule will be in place – please reference the modified schedule.
- 7) Junior Market Goat Show Rule 6.
Wether goats must weigh a minimum of 50 pounds with no maximum weight.
- 8) Junior Market Rabbit Show Rule 2.
If the show is held on the alternative show date of February 26th and 27th there will be no maximum weight or age requirement for market rabbits.
- 9) Single Fryer Show Rule 4.
If the show is held on the alternative show date of February 26th and 27th there will be no maximum weight or age requirement for market rabbits.

*Premium Auction: As this is a fluid situation the Val Verde Junior Livestock Show Board is prepared to change the format of the traditional sale if needed to comply with all local, state and Texas 4-H Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors will receive predetermined premiums if a traditional sale is not a feasible option. The premium amounts will be set by the Val Verde Junior Livestock Show Board.
