I. GENERAL INFORMATION:

Applications are accepted for the Farmer's Fund from October 15 - November 15, 2022.

II. PROCESS

The following describes process of how to apply for Small Farm Institute Farmer's Fund programs:

- 1st) Fill out a Small Farm Institute Enrolment Form
- 2nd) Complete the Farmer's Fund Application and provide appropriate documentation.
- **3rd**) Submit application by deadline.
 - a. Return application to CEP Extension Agent for your county

- III. Applications are received, evaluated, ranked, and approved by November 20, 2022. Applications are awarded based on ranking, locations, need based, and first come first served approach. Applicants are responsible for completing and filing application. Farmers Fund is open to all eligible agricultural producers. Applicants are strongly encouraged to work with local CEP Extension Agent.

III. ELIGIBILITY

Socially disadvantage, limited resources, underrepresented, farmers, ranchers and forest landowners who are currently owning or renting agricultural land are eligible. Farmers Fund assistance can be provided for Heirs property issues and all types of agricultural operations, including:

- Conventional and organic
- Specialty crops and commodity crops
- Forestry
- Wildlife
- Livestock operations
